

Phase 3 - Client goes through MRT (More Recognition Therapy) with 16 steps to a more productive life doing what is right. He compared this phase to the Rotary 4 Way Test and spoke of similarities of each step.

Phase 4 – Client goes through 6 months of after care watch to make sure they stay on track and become productive adults in society.

Other facts offered by Judge Lanier and his assistant, Elrick Nelson, during the question and answer period are: Lafourche Drug Court currently has 99 clients. It is allotted 100 maximum clients. The success rate is very low – about 2%. A successful graduate is defined as a client going 2 years without a recurring incident. Almost all

addicts will use drugs again, so the Drug Court has an open door policy to take a client back in the program to help get back on track again. incident. Almost all
