Mr. Neziyanya is a Multi-Paul Harris Fellow, a member of the Paul Harris Society, a Bequest Society member, a Benefactor; and a major donor. In 2014, Francis was elected to serve as District Governor for the Rotary year 2016-2017, and it is with great humility and appreciation that he embraces this opportunity to serve his community, and fellow Rotarians through philanthropic service that further exemplifies the very essence of Rotarian altruism. Mr. Neziyanya has donated countless hours, as well as other resources to the Zachary Community School System which has been recognized as the number one school district in the State of Louisiana for eleven years in a row. He was selected and served as a Steering Committee Member for her the Zachary Ameri-

Francis is a graduate of Southern University, in Baton Rouge, with a Bachelor's degree in Accounting.
