EARL YOUNG

Earl Young (born 4×100 m and 4×400 m February 14, 1941) is a relays. retired American sprinter. He competed at the 1960 Olympics and won a gold medal in the 4×400 m relay setting a new world record. He finished sixth at the 1963 Pan American Games, where he won a silver medal. In January 2012, he was diagnosed with Acute Myeloid Leukemia, an aggressive type of blood cancer. This threw him into another huge race: one of his life. In January 2012, with time running out, a genetic match
